Someone is coming - John 1.19-28

The Jews had long anticipated the coming of the Messiah (Christ)

John did not take the opportunity to glorify himself

John's purpose was to prepare the way of the Lord

John

"Behold, the Lamb of God" - John 1.29-34

The figure of a lamb was connected to the redemption of sin

John recognized Jesus' authority and deity

John testified about Jesus as an eyewitness

John

"We have found the Messiah"- John 1.35-42

Jesus' invitation is simple "Come and see"

If you're not a Peter or a Paul, be an Andrew

There is power in setting high expectations for someone else

John

"We have found Him of who Moses wrote" – John 1.43-46

Phillip recognized Jesus as the fulfillment of prophecy

Phillip testified to Jesus after witnessing Him

Phillip told Nathanael to examine Jesus for himself

John

"You are the Son of God, You are the King of Israel" - John 1.47-51

Jesus knows us, long before we come to know Him

We must recognize Jesus as our God and our King

Our faith has been confirmed by the signs that Jesus did
