"Supernatural explanations are worse than none at all, because they do the opposite of what explanations should do. Explanations should be considered only if they have the potential for replacing confusion and misunderstanding with clear insights and improved understanding. (As when well-understood, natural mechanisms are shown to explain what once seemed a bewildering array of observed phenomena.) ...

But using supernatural agents or miracles in an explanation only adds more mystery and bewilderment than was present to begin with. The supernatural, by definition, is always more mysterious, more unknowable and more bewildering than anything that can be found or observed in nature." (*Ibid.*)
