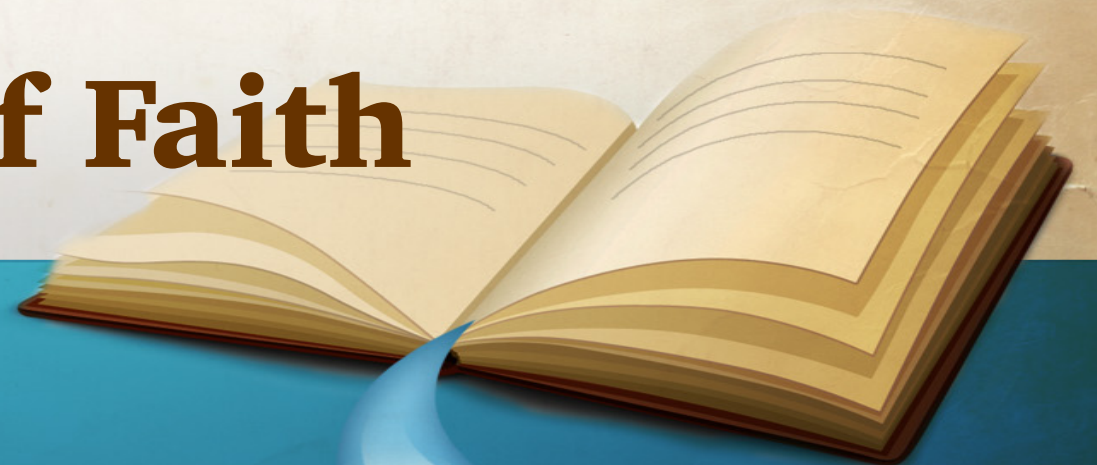

The Cure

- **“It was not that this man sinned, or his parents”**
 - Sometimes ailments are just the result of living in a sin-cursed world
- **“I am the light of the world”**
 - Jesus’ purpose was to reveal the truth of God to the world
- **“Go, wash in the pool of Siloam”**
 - By physically healing this man, Jesus substantiated His claims about spiritual revelation

The Confession

➤ **“He is a prophet”**

- The man born blind concluded that Jesus had been sent from God

➤ **“Why, this is an amazing thing!”**

- The man born blind offers 4 lines of evidence for Jesus’ divine origin

➤ **“Lord I believe”**

- On the basis of the revealed truth, the man born blind had no choice but to believe in Jesus

The Consequence

- **“For judgment I came into the world”**
 - The revelation of God’s will both delivers and condemns
- **“that those who do not see may see”**
 - Jesus’ purpose in revelation was reconciliation and rejection
- **“[Because] you say, ‘We see,’ your guilt remains.”**
 - Blatant rejection of the will of God causes us to be guilty of sin
