What Bible Writers Said:

- You do not question it – Eccl. 8:4; 1 Tim. 6:15.
- You do not add to or take away from it – Deut. 12:32; Rev. 22:18.
- You do not transgress it – 2 John 9.

A very serious approach to Bible authority!



The King's Absolute Authority

What Bible Characters Understood:

- Balaam: You do not do less or more than what God says – Num. 22:18
- Joshua: You do not turn to the right or left of what God says – Josh. 23:6

How many churches are teaching and practicing that exacting obedience?



The King's Absolute Authority

2 Examples of Failure to Obey:

- Nadab and Abihu – Lev. 10:1-3

It makes no difference how much you got right,
if you get one thing wrong.

God doesn't have to be specific about what NOT to do,
when He has specified what TO do.

No justification in "God didn't say not to!"



The King's Absolute Authority

2 Examples of Failure to Obey:

- Uzzah – 1 Chron. 13:7-12

Time doesn't negate God's commands.

A good heart doesn't negate God's commands.

Our perceived special circumstance doesn't
negate God's commands.

Two wrongs don't make a right.

*What to do when
we get it wrong
the first time?*

*Go back and
do it right –
1 Chron. 15:12-15*
