In this story:

- **Salvation based on a condition – vs. 31.**
 - **“Unless . . .” Still danger of loss of life.**
 - **Everyone had to stay in the ship to realize the promised salvation.**

In this story:

- **An area of salvation – vs. 31.**
 - **“in the ship.”**
 - **No one argued about salvation being an irrevokable gift because of God’s promise.**
 - **All stayed in the ship, thus all were saved.**

In our salvation story:

- **A promise from God of salvation.**
 - **1 Tim. 2:4 – God desires all to be saved.**
 - **2 Pet. 3:9 – God is not willing for any to perish.**
 - **2 Tim. 1:12 – Paul knew that God was able to keep him to salvation.**
 - **Eph. 2:8-9 – Not based on our wisdom or skill.**
 - **Rom. 6:23 – Death is earned; life is gifted.**

In our salvation story:

- **Our salvation is conditional.**
 - **Luke 13:5 – “Unless you repent . . .”**
 - **Mat. 18:3 – “Unless you are converted . . .”**
 - **John 3:5 – “Unless one is born of water and the Spirit . . .”**
 - **John 3:5 – “Unless your righteousness exceeds righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees . . .”**

- **Our salvation is conditional.**
 - **Mark 16:16 – Believe and be baptized.**
 - **Acts 2:38 – Repent and be baptized.**
 - **Rom. 10:10 – Believe and confess.**

In our salvation story:

- **There is an area of our salvation.**
 - Eph. 1:3 – “In Christ”
 - Eph. 5:25 , 23 – “The church” (body – Eph. 1:22-23).
 - Gal. 3:27 – We are baptized “into Christ.”
 - Acts 2:47 – We are added by Christ into His church when we are saved.
